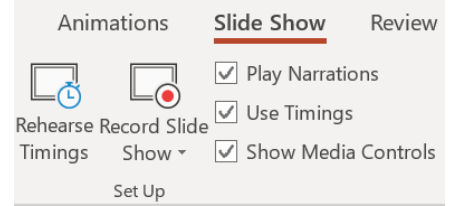

★ Record Narrated Slide Show and Export as a Video

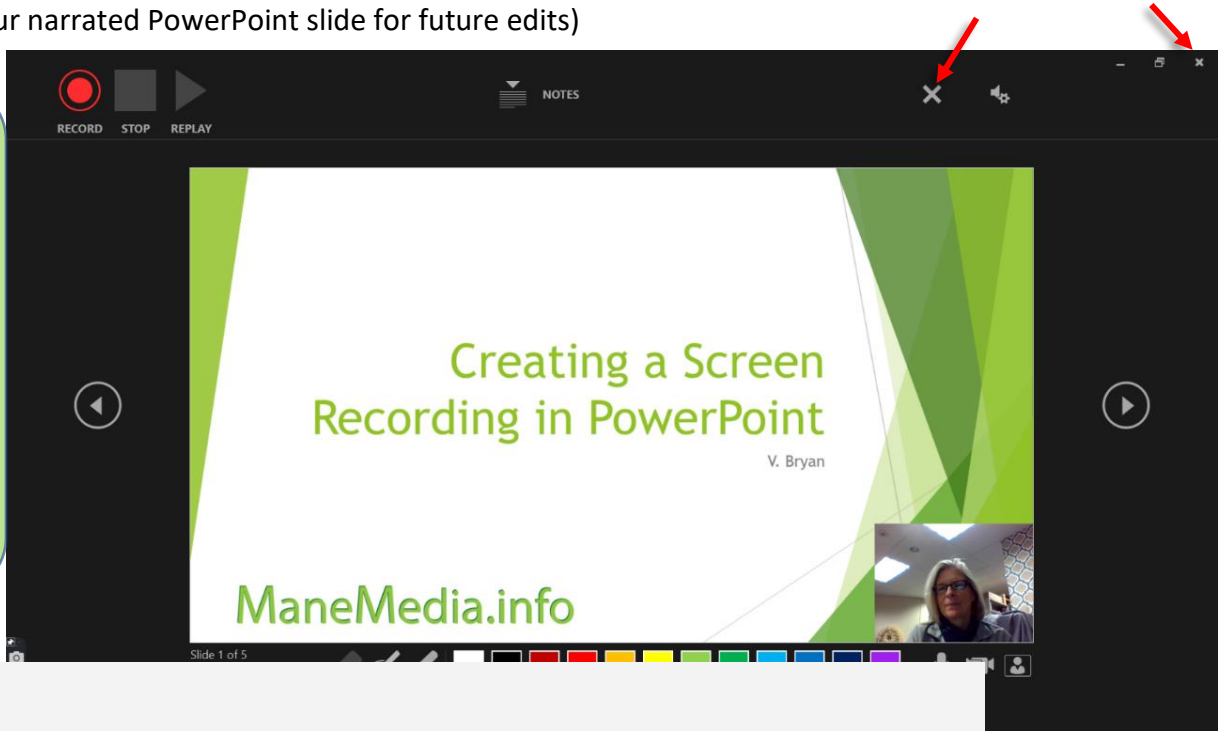
For simply recording your PowerPoint slides with narration use the **desktop app**

- Select **Slide Show / Record Slide Show**
- In the Media Controls on the lower right toggle  to display your webcam video in the lower right of the slides as you present, as desired
- To save the recording as a **.mp4** video file, select **File / Export / Create a Video** (also save your narrated PowerPoint slide for future edits)



Narration is attached and can be rerecorded on each individual slide, experiment!

- Far upper right X exits recording screen
- X above the slide clears recording for that slide

Create a Video

Save your presentation as a video that you can burn to a disc, upload to the web, or email

- Includes all recorded timings, narrations, ink strokes, and laser pointer gestures
- Preserves animations, transitions, and media
